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The idea:

Stop lup music books or folders to the show. All notes in the computer, and when calling up and displaying a sheet music file it is also best to automatically set the keyboard correctly to the title.

ATMObyte Sempra-Edition is a complex software, with an unlimited number of titles and the associated notes or texts in <u>PDF format</u>. The titles can be distributed to any number of playlists. Titles can be assigned to 12 different <u>set's</u> and the desired set can be activated with one click.

For each title, a sound file in mp3 format can be deposited and played as required.

With the scanning function integrated in **ATMObyte Sempra-Edition**, existing paper notes can be scanned directly. The correct assignment and saving in <u>PDF format</u> are automatic. Of course, already existing PDF files can be used. Calling a title not only displays the corresponding notes, but the title-related registration of the connected **SEMPRA** is called automatically.

The software runs under all Windows systems.

Mac systems require the installation of VMware Fusion beforehand. If a tablet computer is used, the software automatically adapts to the position of the tablet. When used vertically (portrait), the display automatically switches to 1-sided display, so that the sheet of music is displayed on the entire display. **ATMObyte Sempra-Edition** but only start when the desired position of the display is done.

1.1 Installation from CD

After inserting the CD into the computer, the installation program starts automatically. If this does not happen please start the file *demo.exe* on the CD with a double-click.

1.2 Installation of the download version

In the download version, the program is automatically installed.

The following 2 menu options are now available:

ATMObyte Sempra-Edition

Program Description

The **ATMObyte Sempra-Edition** installation routine installs the program on your computer. The installation directory can be chosen freely and is preset to **C: **.

Installation is not possible in the directories **C: \ Programs** and **C: \ Programs (x86)**. These directories are systemically important. An installation would only require a change in the registry be possible and that should be avoided.

Only the folder **ATMObyteBSE** with all files belonging to the program will be copied to the hard disk and no changes are made to the system or the REGISTRY.

During the installation this message can come from Windows Defender,



but that has to do with Microsoft and their caution and

not with problems or dangers of the software itself.

Of course, Windows knows neither the program nor the manufacturer, so security is important first. You also get this message when installing many other programs.

The installation is carried out by clicking on **More information** and then on **Install anyway**.

When first started, the software starts as a <u>DEMO version</u>. To license the software, from the <u>DEMO version</u> to make a <u>full version</u>, the entry of a license code is necessary.

The entry is made in the menu item SERVICE under license.



For the creation of the license code the serial number is always necessary.

First steps

At the first call the software starts as DEMO version. In the DEMO version the software can be extensively tested.

The only limitations are that the notes are overwritten with **DEMO**.

All functions, including the SEMPRA control, can be used without restrictions.

If a license code is available, the software can be registered with this code and is a full version.

If you want to call up the registration of the keyboard for the title you are calling, so the keyboard must first be set once to the correct <u>MIDI channel</u>.

This channel is specified by **ATMObyte Sempra-**

Edition and can be changed under Service-> Settings.

When installing **ATMObyte Sempra-Edition** for the first time, this is channel 16.

Keyboard settings

To use the registration call of the connected keyboard just change the MIDI setting of the SEMPRA as follows:

If the MIDI channel 16 is used, the following settings apply to the SEMPRA: MIDI IN Channel Preset Change 16 MIDI OUT Channel Preset Change 16

DEMO version

At the first call the software starts as DEMO version. In the DEMO version the software can be extensively tested.

The only limitations are that the notes are overwritten with **DEMO**.

All functions, including the SEMPRA control, can be used without restrictions.

FULL version

In the full version, is after entering a correct license code, all functions listed in the description are executable. The coverage of the notes with **DEMO** in the DEMO version is no longer visible.

menu bar

The individual functions of **ATMObyte Sempra-Edition** can be called up via the buttons in the menu bar.



With *program* the ATMObyte Sempra-Edition can be stopped

With **Service** you switch to the settings area of the program and important program properties can be changed.

With **extended** you get to the <u>global settings</u> for the program.

Under LICENSE the LICENSE will be activated as a full version.

With PDF Manual the program documentation can be printed out as PDF.

The internal program description is called up via **Help F1**. This call can be made at any point in the program at any time.

If **Display 2** is activated, the notes from the subdirectory <u>PDF \ Display2</u> are displayed. Standard is PDF \ Display1.

With the <u>wireless display adapter</u>, the PC is wirelessly connected to a monitor or projector.

With **PRESETs** the 20 available PRESETs are called. These can be edited and / or played.

Keyboard on / off displays or hides an on-screen keyboard.

With the *country flags* the language of the program can be changed.

The two switches Software Control und and SEMPRA Control affect the control behavior of ATMObyte Sempra-Edition.

If the switch Software Control is deactivated, the registration will be made for a title call the SEMPRA does not change. Only the notes are displayed. This allows playing a variety of titles with the same registration of the SEMPRA.

If the switch SEMPRA Control is deactivated, it will be activated on a SEMPRA preset call Seite 14 von 79

the note display does not change. So it can be the displayed title with different SEMPRA settings are played.

Title

A title is an entry in one of any number of <u>titlelists</u>. The number of titles in a <u>titlelist</u> is unlimited.

A title is called by its name.

This name also assigns the notes and any existing mp3 files or video files to the title.

These files must be named exactly as the title. If the <u>title</u> is Yesterday, the corresponding sheet PDF is Yesterday.pdf. The mp3 file Yesterday.mp3 and the video file Yesterday.mp4.

If **ATMObyte Sempra-Edition's** internal <u>scanning</u> program is used to scan the scores, this will automatically generate the name of the <u>PDF file</u> correctly and the sheet music is stored in the directory. \ PDF \ Display1. The selection of a title can be done in different ways.



Mauscrollrad

The scroll wheel of the mouse scrolls through the title list.

arrow keys

Use the arrow keys to the left of the title list to maneuver.

onsceen keyboard

The title is selected using the screen keyboard below the title list. The on-screen keyboard can be displayed and hidden as desired.

The layout of the screen keyboard automatically adapts to the language setting of the PC.

This is done by means of the keyboard on / off button.

All functions can be performed by mouse or with a touchmonitor by finger.

Searching for a <u>title</u> using the on-screen keyboard or the PC keyboard can be done after the <u>title</u>, is alphabetically or it can also be searched for a letter sequence in the <u>title</u> name. To do so, select Search for below Title bar or Title content below the menu bar.

If the <u>title</u> search is set to the beginning of the title, the first title that starts with **B** is selected by entering the letter **B**. If one enters now the letter **A** one ends up with the first title with the initial letters **BA**, e.g. Baker Street. If you enter an **R** and there is no title with the initial letters **BAR** in the title list, the first title is immediately marked with the initial letter **R**. During the title search for content, the entered letter sequence does not have to be at the beginning of the <u>title</u>,

but may be somewhere in the title name. All titles are then displayed in which the entered letter sequence exists.

If you enter e.g. If you enter the word ROSE, all titles appear with this letter sequence.



When searching for keywords, the middle touch panel displays all the keywords used in the program.

The most important input is the title name. Without this input can not be saved.

For each <u>title keywords</u> can be assigned. After this, the <u>title</u> can then be searched.

The keywords already used in the program are listed in the list of tags and can be accepted with a double-click.

If a new keyword is entered, it is automatically added to the keyword list. Keywords can be the artist, the composer, the genre, the key, the epoch, and so on. The entries for registration have 3 values. 1. the registration bank 2. the registration memory to be started with. 3.the variant with which the song should be started

The values can be entered manually.

It is more elegant if the values are taken directly from the SEMPRA. Simply click on the green button again and then select the desired registration in the SEMPRA. All registry values from SEMPRA will then be automatically transferred to the software.

The <u>Scan Scores</u> button allows scores to be scanned directly from the program and the title. This feature is detailed in <u>Scanning Scores</u>.

Title> Edit in the menu bar opens the selected title for editing. It then opens the same mask as when creating a new title. There are only the title name and all entered parameters of the title available.

The editing of a title can also be done by a click with the right mouse button on the title name.

The most important input is the title name. Without this input can not be saved. For each title keywords can be assigned. After this, the title can then be searched. The keywords already used in the program are listed in the list of tags and can be accepted with a *double-click*. If a new keyword is entered, it is automatically added to the keyword list.

Keywords can be the artist, the composer, the genre, the key, the epoch, and so on.

The entries for registration are described in Registration.

The <u>Scan Scores</u> button allows scores to be <u>scanned</u> directly from the program and the <u>title</u>. This feature is detailed in <u>Scanning Scores</u>. With Title-> delete in the menu bar a title can be deleted. Deleting can also be done by clicking on the *Del key*. When deleting, only the entry in the title list with all settings is removed.

The **Title-> Copy** function in the menu bar allows you to copy a title.



The title then appears with the same name and the extension **COPY**.

This feature finds the PDF files in the **PDF\Display1** directory, that are not present in the current playlist. If you want to create a title from a displayed PDF, just click on the PDF and in the current title list a title with the name of the PDF is created.

Via **print list** a list with all PDF files in the directory **PDF\D isplay1** is printed out. The PDF's for which a title exists in the current playlist are marked with an **X**. ListPDF

The names for the **SETs** can be changed by clicking with the right mouse button on the **SET** name. If no name is entered for a **SET**, the name is automatically entered as the name.

A title list can contain an unlimited number of titles.

Any number of titlelists can be created.

At the first program start, the playlists are Titellistet00-DEMO - GENOS set with 10 titles as DEMO playlists.

If title ists are created, they start with the number 20.

Creating a new titlelist is done in the menu bar with titlelist-new.



An input window opens and the name of the new list can be assigned.

Deleting a title list is done with *titlelist-> delete* in the menu bar.



By clicking on the corresponding titlelist and confirming the deletion query, the selected titlelist is deleted.

The change between the existing title lists is done by means of *title list-> change* in the menu bar.



In the opening selection window all available titlelists are listed. Click on the desired titlelist to activate it immediately.

If notes are already available in PDF format, they can be used. They just have to be copied into this program folder. The PDF file must match the title name exactly, So for the *title Red Roses*, the PDF file *Red Roses.pdf* must be called. If printed notes are available for the title, they can be scanned in via the integrated <u>scan function</u>.

To do this, a scanner must be connected to the PC via USB.

After the scanning process, the notes are automatically stored in the correct folder and can be immediately called up and displayed with the title.

> There are no further entries like name of the <u>PDF file</u> or number of pages of notes necessary for the <u>title</u>, since this is done automatically by the program.

By clicking on the title name or pressing the *ENTER key* the sheet music for the title is displayed.



By clicking on the title name or pressing the ENTER key In this case, it is a title with several Notidenitenamae. With Exit you go back to the title selection.

If the PDF file has multiple pages and scrolling is necessary, the required buttons for turning pages are visible.

Turning these buttons can also be done via USB footswitch or via Bluetooth foot switch.

When using a monitor with touch function can also be wiping be browsed on the monitor.

If you want to turn pages of the <u>pages from the organ</u>, the command for Turning over in the organ can be placed on an organ switch, e.g. a switch on the footwell.

> If an mp3 file is available, it can be started via the *mp3 button*. This button is only visible if an mp3 file belonging to the title exists.

Whether the control button should appear to the left or right of the notes, can be set under **SERVICE-> Settings** by clicking on the corresponding switch.

s a rule, two-page sheet music always displays 2 pages in parallel. In principle, a 1-sided display is desired, e.g. with small monitors, this can also be set under <u>SERVICE settings</u>.

The note display can also be inverted. The notes then appear in white on a black background. This option should be applied to the display in case of strong light.

Video

For each <u>title</u> a video can be deposited. The videos are always in the directory *VIDEO*.

If there is a video for a <u>title</u>, it will do so in the menu bar with **video** displayed.

Click on this button to test the video playback.

The supported formats is: mp4.

If you want to start the video with the title call, then **Service-> Settings** to put a hook on **video-automati**c.

Is a 2nd screen or projector connected to the computer, so the video is played on this.

If a video cannot be played, it is due to the missing codec for this format. The missing codecs can be installed under **Service-> Settings -> Video Codec**. You can access the PRESETs via **PRESETs** in the menu bar. Up to 20 presets can be created. If a PRESET is provided with <u>titles</u>, the label of the corresponding button is black. For empty PRESETs the label is gray.



In a PRESET any number of <u>titel</u> can be stored in any order. The order can be changed at any time, as well as the content of a PRESET. To edit a PRESET, right-click on the corresponding preset or select the desired preset with a double-click for editing. Now the PRESET is opened for editing and on the left side all <u>titles</u> of the active <u>titlelist</u> are displayed.



Double-clicking on a <u>title</u> in the <u>titlelist</u> will copy it to the PRESET. It is inserted under the blue marked <u>title</u> in the PRESET. Its position can be changed arbitrarily with the arrow keys. The PRESET can be given a name.

With **Preset Print** the contents of the PRESET can be printed out.

The number of tracks contained in the PRESET and the approximate playing time of the entire PRESET are also displayed.



Close will save the PRESET.

To start a PRESET, just click on the corresponding button. Now the first <u>title</u> of the PRESET is called up and the notes are displayed.



A click on immediately calls up the next <u>title</u>. In this button the title following in the preset is displayed.

So you can put together complete programs in the PRESETs and retrieve as needed.

Via via, the PRESET can be ended at any time.

With back the previous <u>title</u> is called.

If you do not want to start a PRESET with the first <u>title</u>, select the edit mode of the corresponding PRESET and double-click on the desired start <u>title</u>. The PRESET will now be played from the start <u>title</u>.

To copy a **preset**, drag the **preset** to the new **preset** while holding down the left mouse button. Then the complete content and the name of the **preset** will be copied.

Audio Record

With ATMObyte SEMPRA-Edition it is possible to make recordings in WAV or MP3 format.
 The recordings are saved in the subdirectory \ MyRecords \ WAV or \ MyRecords \ MP3.
 The existing MP3 files in the \ MP3 subdirectory are not changed or overwritten.
 The recordings can be listened to immediately for checking and e.g. copied to a USB stick.
 If recordings are to be made, this function Audio record must be activated.



The required buttons are then visible next to the score.



To copy the recording, select the storage location and confirm.

This setting only needs to be made once as we are connected to the 0db output of the organ. A value of 60 has proven to be beneficial in order to avoid overloading.

The level of the signal output of the USB sound card can also be adjusted here.



A possible connection between USB sound card and SEMPRA is shown here. **0db IN** and **0db OUT** are located on the back of the SEMPRA. All basic settings are made in the **SERVICE-> expanded**. This affects the MIDI settings, the display and the GEMA settings. Likewise, a complete backup can be made and there is the possibility of a remote maintenance by TeamViewer.

For the MIDI connection, the MIDI channel set in the organ is specified. In our example, this is channel 16 for SEMPRA.

The USB-MIDI adapter used in this case is a Roland UM-ONE. This is selected as a **MIDI IN device** and as a **MIDI OUT device**. If another adapter is used, this is selected.

To use the registration call of the connected keyboard all you have to do is change the SEMPRA's MIDI setting as follows:

This foot switch - PageFlip Dragon - can be connected via Bluetooth as well as via USB. It is freely programmable via Bluetooth. If the footswitch is to be used only for turning pages, So the type - PageFlip Firefly - which can also be connected via Bluetooth is sufficient. The footswitches are also preprogrammed for AKcontrol and offered with the software.

Thus, the software is also very suitable for musicians who do not use a keyboard but want to access a large pool of notes in the computer, e.g. Accordion player or sax player etc.

If the footswitch is only needed to turn the notes, a 2-button footswitch is also available. The foot switches are preprogrammed for **ATMObyte Sempra-Edition** and offered with the software.

Microsoft wireless Display Adapter

With the help of a Microsoft display adapter, a projector or an additional monitor can be connected to the PC If a video belonging to the title is called up manually or with activated <u>video</u> <u>automatic</u>, this is always displayed on the projector or on the additional monitor. To do this, the Microsoft Diaplay adapter must be connected to the HDMI input of the projector or monitor. The USB plug of the adapter is used for the power supply and, if available, is connected to the USB socket on the projector or monitor. Otherwise, the power is supplied via a USB plug-in power supply. If everything is connected and the projector or monitor is switched on, the adapter is displayed on the screen. The connection to the projector or monitor can now be established via **SERVICE -> Wireless Display Adapter**. ATMObyte Sempra-Edition can run on all Windows systems as of Win XP, even under Win 10.

On MAC systems **ATMObyte Sempra-Edition** also runs, but VMware Fusion must be installed beforehand.

There is no special power required from the PC. The standard computers offered today meet the requirements of the software.

> ALL IN ONE PC's are best suited with a touch screen. You only have one device. These PCs are available in different sizes.

For a fixed installation on your home keyboard, this can be a bit bigger screen, about 23 ".

On the go, a netbook of about 13 "is enough.

To use the internal help documentation), there are 2 possibilities. The first option is to press the *F1 key* on the keyboard. The second possibility is the call via **Service-> Help** in the menu bar.



How can I simulate the right mouse button with a finger on a touch display?

Very easily.

Leave your finger on the desired position of the display (about 1 second), until a mark becomes visible around the finger (Win7 a square, Win8 and Win10 a circle). This basically applies under Windows and not only for **ATMObyte Sempra-Edition**.

In the area **SERVICE-> expanded** can with a Click on remote maintenance to connect to the internet. It then starts the remote maintenance program TEAMVIEWER. This allows direct help via the Internet.

Enter comments in sheet music

The existing PDF notes in ATMObyte can easily be supplemented with additional comments, etc.

Select the title, but do not call the notes yet and press F10 on the PC keyboard.

Now the PDF file with the notes is opened with the PDF program, which is set as the default program under Windows.

In general, this is e.g. the free **Acrobat Reader**. More recommendable is the free program **FOXIT READER**. Of course, any other PDF program can be used with the edit function.

Creation and assignment of push button macros on the SEMPRA to turn the notes in ATMOBYTE

You can e.g. the rocker switch, the F-button below the display or - if available - the Use the pistons of your SEMPRA to turn the notes in ATMOBYTE. To do this, set up First, insert two button macros - one to page forward, one to page backward, and organize assign these macros to the desired (foot) switches.

We take the necessary settings in the menu**Taster & Regler – Taster-Preset** edit the SEMPRA. First call up this menu:

- # Call up the BMC menu of the SEMPRA using the **MENU** button
 - # Select the item in the menu Taster & Regler, then select the item in the submenu
 Taster-Preset editieren. This takes you to the corresponding edit menu.

The last thing we have to do is specify the **destination**, i.e. the MIDI interface via which the macro should later send the controller.Here we select the MIDI interface via which the PC with the ATMOBYTE software is connected to the SEMPRA In our example this is the MIDI Out 1 socket, so we select the **MIDI 1** interface as the destination.

Set MIDI channels for push button macros

Perhaps you already noticed when assigning the two macros to the rocker buttons, that the fields in the Part column next to the two newly assigned sill switches suddenly activated. Here again we see the destination, i.e. the MIDI interface via which the corresponding function can be sent later when using the button, and also the respective MIDI channels 1... 16. So there can be a separate MIDI channel for each of the two buttons via which the controller function is then activated when the rocker switch is pressed be sent. # Please set channel **16** for both rocker buttons in the corresponding fields, because ATMOBYTE is preconfigured in such a way that it expects the controller for the sheet music on this channel.



Save button preset

We have now made all the necessary settings and can now use the new assignment Save as a button preset. If you have made the setting in an existing push button preset you only need to press the **STORE** button, the button preset that you want to take over want to update in the list that appears and save with **ENTER** to confirm.

If you change the name for the button preset to be updated or a new one If you want to save the button preset in a free position, you should now first create a sensible one Assign a name for the new push button preset:

•# On the right, tap on the **Change preset name** field. A text entry box will appear.

Enter a name in the box, such as "Notes swell"

•# Confirm your entry with **ENTER**.



Now we can finally save the new push button preset under the selected name:

•# Press the **STORE** button on the control panel to initiate the storage process.

The new button preset is now saved and can then be called up in the usual way and used.

Call up a multi-page note file in ATMOBYTE and press the two alternately Rocker switch. If you have made and saved all settings correctly, you should the right switch scrolls one (double) page each time it is pressed, the left one Scroll back the rocker switch accordingly.

Print out the title list

There is no direct printing option for a title list. But there is still a little detour.

! Go to the Presets area

- 2. Right-click to open an empty preset for editing
 - 3. Click on "Add all titles to the PRESET"
- 4. Give the preset a name meaning the name of the title list

5. Now print the preset.

Now you have a printout of the current title list. If you have previously selected a SET or keywords in the title list, the above function can of course be used to print out the selected title list.
